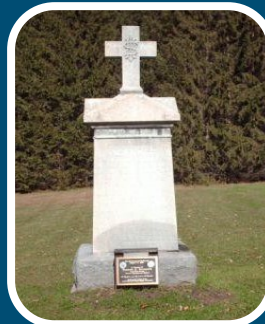

INDIAN HILL

*"In a bark chapel on this spot,
the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass
was first offered in
New York State by
Rev. Joseph M. Chaumonot,
Sunday 14, November 1655."*

According to Jesuit records, the first recorded Mass in New York State was said within the boundaries of St. Ann's parish at the site known as Indian Hill. On November 14, 1655, Mass was offered in a crude shelter built by the Indians for Fr. Joseph Chaumonot who had come with Fr. Claude Dablon from Quebec to Onondaga territory following earlier exploration by Fr. Simon LeMoyne. Following the American Revolution, the Manlius area was served by Immaculate Conception in Pompey.

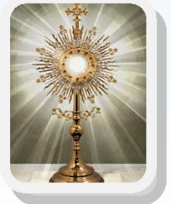
